### ✓ WILL BE CHIPPED:

- ✓ **Fresh Material:** material less than 4 weeks old makes better chip
- ✓ **Branches: minimum length 1m, maximum length 3m**
- ✓ **Branches: maximum diameter of 15cm**
- ✓ **3 cubic metres (3m<sup>3</sup>)**
- ✓ Stack branches end to end
- ✓ Place material neatly on the nature strip
- ✓ Keep clear of paths and driveways
- ✓ Remove chipped material promptly and use in your garden



### ✗ WILL NOT BE CHIPPED:

- ✗ Weeds in flower or seed will not be chipped
- ✗ Bamboo and Pussy Willow will not be chipped
- ✗ Small material (grass, leaves & twigs) - put in your compost bin
- ✗ Root balls, vines or ferns
- ✗ Palm fronds cannot be chipped
- ✗ Material from vacant blocks, reserves or non-residential properties
- ✗ Mass clearing, storm damage or hazard reduction. These works must be done by a qualified contractor and must comply with Tree Preservation Orders.

### TREE PRESERVATION ORDERS

You must have permission to prune trees that are more than 4 metres tall and/or have a branch spread of more than 4 metres.
