- A Road and Footpath Opening Permit must be obtained before any works are carried out in the road reserve.
- PLEASE NOTE THAT AN OPENING PERMIT DOES NOT PROVIDE APPROVAL FOR ANY WORKS TO COMMENCE WITHOUT NOTIFICATION TO THE RESTORATIONS OFFICER.
- After clearance given by the Restorations Officer and work completed, the site must be left in accordance with the specifications listed below and the Restorations Officer notified of the completion.  
FAILURE TO DO SO WILL RESULT IN EXTRA RESTORATION CHARGES.
- The Restorations Officer will measure the area to be restored. Council will repair the damage and the invoice will be forwarded to the Applicant.

**SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE CONTRACTOR**

It is the responsibility of the contractor to **temporarily restore** the damages done to Council's assets (roads and/or footpaths) **prior to permanent restoration** works being carried out by Council. The specification for the temporary restoration work to be carried out by the contractor is as follows:

“The damaged area, or roads and paved footpaths shall be filled with insitu material to a depth of not less than 150 mm + 50 mm from the top of existing seal. The last 150 mm shall be filled with DGB 20 (Road Base) and **COMPACTED**. Finally, the DGB 20 (Road Base) shall be topped using 50 mm of bitumen cold mix and **COMPACTED**. The contractor shall leave the work site in a safe and clean condition.”

The damaged areas of earth and grass footpaths shall be filled with insitu material and **COMPACTED**. The area shall be top soiled and grass seeded with a suitable blend of grass seed for Sparse Grass areas. Lawn areas of footpaths will have the turf removed and replaced by the Contractor. Gravel areas of footpaths will be restored with material matching existing material in quality and appearance. All areas will be left level with surrounding surfaces and in a safe, clean condition in Accordance with Blue Mountains City Council's Erosion and Siltration Policy.

**Failure to meet the above conditions will incur further costs to the contractor in terms of additional restoration charges.**
