Blackheath Caravan Park is ideally located for a family holiday. Directly opposite is the Memorial Park with its free swimming pool, children's playground and duck pond, all in a beautiful rhododendron garden. At nearby Govetts Leap you can enjoy panoramic views of the Grose Valley, go bush walking, have a picnic or visit the National Parks and Wildlife Heritage Centre. The Megalong Valley, which begins about five kilometres from Blackheath, is a popular spot for horseriding, swimming and picnicking. Blackheath shopping centre, 1/2 km from the caravan park, offers an attractive selection of antique and craft shops, coffee shops and restaurants. Bring your clubs and enjoy a round of golf at Blackheath Golf Club.
