



PARKS IN THE BLUE MOUNTAINS

Memorial Park, Mount Victoria

Location: On the corner of the Great Western Highway and Station Street, the park is central in the village (parking off Montgomery Street).

Facilities: Picnic tables, play equipment, toilets, tennis court and historical items.



Memorial Gardens, Blackheath

Location: Turn off the highway on Govetts Leap Road, and third left into Prince Edward Street. Parking on Prince Edward Street.

Facilities: Picnic tables, toilets, picnic shelters, electric BBQs, extensive play equipment including the restored historical equipment (see picture), swimming pool (open during summer), and open grassland.



Bert Hinkler Park, Katoomba

Location: Katoomba Street (500m down on the left from the main shopping area). Street parking.

Facilities: Historical items, play equipment, toilets, picnic seating and picnic shelter.

Wilson Park, Wentworth Falls

Location: On the corner of Great Western Highway and Falls Road, Wentworth Falls. The park is located opposite the School of Arts, and 100m near the village centre, on the other side of the highway.

Facilities: Toilets, play equipment, picnic tables, picnic shelters, adjacent to tennis courts and lawn bowls facility, and is the trail head for the Charles Darwin Walk (there are many steps on this walk).



Wilson Park, Lawson

Location: Turn off the Great Western Highway into Badgery Crescent, left into Loftus Street, then right into St Bernards Drive. Caution: St Bernards Drive is a two way street which is narrow and winding.



Gloria Park, Hazelbrook

Location: Exit the Great Western Highway at Oaklands Road, Hazelbrook and turn left into Lester Avenue.

Facilities: Toilets, sports oval, play equipment, picnic seating, next to tennis and lawn bowls.





PARKS IN THE BLUE MOUNTAINS

Corridor of Oaks and Jackson Park, Faulconbridge

Location: Turn off the Great Western Highway into Sir Henry's Parade (opposite Georges Crescent), Faulconbridge, and continue left across the railway line. The Corridor of Oaks is first on your left, Jackson Park immediately next on your right. Parking on Wigram Road, near Jackson Park.

Facilities: Walking through the Oaks planted by or in memory of Australia's Prime Ministers. Jackson Park has picnic tables, picnic shelter, play equipment and toilets.



Buttenshaw Park, Springwood

Location: Turn off the Great Western Highway just after Churchill Street. The park is located mid-way between Faulconbridge and Springwood. Formalised car park adjacent to the highway. Access to the park also off Plateau Road.

Facilities: Toilets, formal gardens, play equipment, picnic seating, adjacent to tennis courts and small skateboard facility.



Thomas Park, Blaxland

Location: Turn off the Highway at Wilson Road, Blaxland and left into Boorea Street.

Facilities: Play equipment, picnic seating, shelter and large open area.

Glenbrook Park, Glenbrook

Location: Behind the Visitors Information Centre, Great Western Highway, Glenbrook.

Facilities: Electric BBQs, toilets, picnic seating, picnic shelters, play equipment, sports oval, adjacent to shops, tennis court and information centre.
