EXTRA BULKY HOUSEHOLD WASTE COLLECTIONS FOR 2009/10

The following dates are available for any bulky household waste collections in addition to the annual clean up collection. The charge for any additional services is \$88.00 **per cubic metre** (\$40.00 for pensioners), **no limit on the number of cubic metres removed**.

No green waste is to be placed out for the household collections.

TOO MUCH RUBBISH FOR YOUR BIG BIN?



Council provides 3 seasonal waste services (2 chipping and 1 bulky waste) to all developed residentially rated properties. These services offer a solution to the disposal of green waste and bulky household items. The charge for these 2 services is incorporated in the owner's domestic waste charge, which appears on the rate notice.

The **green waste services** generally occur in Spring and Autumn each year. The service offers to mulch up to 2 m³ of green waste per property. The mulch can be utilised by the householder. Householders will be notified when the service will be in their area.



The **bulky household item collection service (household clean up)** occurs in Winter/Spring each year. The service offers up to 2 m³ of household items per property. Householders will be notified when the collection service will be in their area.

Remember: Whitegoods (fridges, washing machines, etc) are recyclable and can be taken to Council's Waste Management Facilities for free. The facilities are located at Attunga Rd, Blaxland and Woodlands Road, Katoomba. The hours are 8am to 5pm, 7 days a week, except Christmas Day and Good Friday

EXTRA SERVICES

Extra services are **ONLY** provided for the removal of bulky household items. These extra services are charged at \$88.00 per m³, pensioners \$40.00 per m³. There is no limit on the amount to be removed.

Should an extra service be required an application form should be completed and lodged with the payment to Council. There are set dates for these extra services.

For further information or to arrange an extra service, simply telephone Council (02) 4780 5000 or (02) 4723 5000 (from Linden to Lapstone – local call charge) OR visit the Katoomba or Springwood office.

How does Council collect these extra services?

- All waste material is to be placed out on the nature strip before 5.00 am on the day of collection. Extra services cannot be transferred to another property. The cost of any extra services is **not refundable**.

The extra service will collect articles that are placed out on the footpath such as:

- Old refrigerators and freezers (recommended they be degassed if refrigerant coolant still present in the unit) with the door removed.
- Stoves, mattresses, furniture.
- Small amounts of domestic fencing, corrugated iron, plasterboard, doors, guttering, hot water heaters.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

- All items must: be easily lifted by two people.
- Loose items should be not more than 1 metre in length and should be bagged or bundled and tied in lots weighing not more than 20 kgs.
- Where possible, bulky and heavy items should be broken down into their component parts.
- Cardboard boxes are not to be used as containers as they are unsuitable in wet conditions.

THE EXTRA SERVICES DO NOT COLLECT:

- Car bodies and/or heavy car parts.
- Tanks (water, septic etc).
- Organic waste including garden prunings. Use the 3 green waste services throughout the year.
- Hazardous wastes. Household chemical wastes can be taken to Council's Waste Management Facilities on 2 advertised occasions during the year.
- Liquid wastes. Council's Waste Management Facilities are not licensed to dispose of liquid wastes.
- Cardboard and other kerbside recyclables. These can be left out for collection by Council's Recycling Contractor.
- General building waste such as bricks, windows, large quantities of wall or roof sheeting.
- Asbestos products. These must be handled as hazardous waste subject to Workcover guidelines and cannot be left unattended on the footpath.
- Trade waste.

Private arrangements should be made for the removal of the above items and details of contractors can be found in the local newspapers or the Yellow Pages of the telephone book. Alternatively, the materials may be taken to Council's Waste Management Facilities at Katoomba or Blaxland. The disposal charge is dependent upon the type and weight of the waste.

Any items outside the above acceptable limits will not be collected even if booked with Council. Please check with Council prior to making application for service, as application fees are not refundable.
