The Hatobuilico Friendship Committee is an advisory committee of Council and its role is to provide advice to Council on how the formal friendship relationship with the community of the sub-district of Hatobuilico in Timor-Leste is progressing. Its main activities are:

- Supporting the work of Blue Mountains community organisations which are fundraising and/or developing community projects with the local community in Hatobuilico.
- Providing information and advice to Council on developments in Australian/Timor-Leste relationships, including the establishment of local government in Timor-Leste.
- Receiving visiting dignitaries from Timor-Leste.
- The committee comprises two councillors and up to 10 community members. It meets quarterly (generally on a Monday evening from 7-9pm at the Council Chambers in Katoomba) to discuss ways in which our Blue Mountains community can strengthen the friendship relationship with the people of Hatobuilico.

The Hatobuilico Friendship Committee is seeking three (3) new committee members. We are seeking expressions of interest from people who are:

- Passionate about social justice and strengthening our friendship relationship with the people of the sub-district of Hatobuilico, Timor-Leste
- Interested in providing advice to Council on community-based activities that support our friendship with Hatobuilico, Timor-Leste
- Live in the Blue Mountains Local Government Area.
