

# Resource Recovery & Waste Management Facilities (RRWMF) Fees and Charges 2019/2020



**Open 7 days a week, 8am - 4.45pm**

Council does **not to accept waste generated from outside the city.**

Where a person using the RRWMF is required to reweigh, a deposit will be payable on entry to the RRWMF and the vehicle will be weighed on entry and exit. The relevant fee will be deducted from the deposit and the remainder refunded to the user. The fee required may exceed the deposit and an extra charge above the deposit may be required.

**Katoomba RRMWF** only vehicles up to 4.5 tonnes are accepted and all waste must be unloaded by hand - no tipping.

**All charges include provision for the NSW Government's Waste & Environment Levy (\$82.70 per tonne) and GST, as applicable.**

## RECYCLING

The following are accepted **FREE** of charge if **source separated/sorted and uncontaminated**:

- Household recyclables including paper; cardboard; glass containers; rigid plastic containers from the kitchen, bathroom and laundry; steel and aluminium can and liquid paper board containers eg. milk cartons
- Scrap metal including car bodies
- Car batteries
- White goods e.g. stoves, refrigerators etc
- Motor oils
- Expanded polystyrene

Household Hazardous Chemical Collections are held at certain times through the year. The dates and times will be advertised in the local paper.

## SPECIAL WASTE - BLAXLAND ONLY

Separated timber (treated or untreated)	\$213*	per tonne
Separated bricks, unreinforced concrete, roof tiles, earthenware pipes	\$213*	per tonne
Clean fill (no organic/building rubble or rocks)	\$91*	per tonne
Special waste able to be buried with other waste (includes sheet asbestos up to 250kg)	\$377	per tonne
Special waste requiring separate/supervised burial (applies to asbestos waste over 250kg)	\$414	per tonne

## CAR AND TRUCK TYRES

Whole car & 4WD tyres (max 5 tyres)	\$10-\$15 each	
Whole truck tyres	\$15.50-\$22.50 each	
Large whole truck tyres	\$255	per tonne
Large heavy plant tyres (earthmoving or similar)	\$408	per tonne

## Reuse shed - Katoomba and Blaxland

- Goods out are **free**
- NO** electrical goods are to go into the reuse shed
