Introduction

The Seniors Week recognition awards acknowledge the contribution that individuals and organisations have made to the Seniors of the Blue Mountains community.

The Blue Mountains City Council offers two categories of nomination - **individuals** or **organisations**.

To be eligible for an individual award you have to be 60 years of age or older and have made a significant contribution to the lives of older people in the mountains. To nominate an organisation, the organisation must support older people in our community.

Examples can include:

- Individuals who volunteer to do activities that benefit seniors.
- Individuals who provide a caring role to a senior member of the community.
- Organisations and or individuals that contribute to the well being of seniors through the raising of funds e.g. Rotary.
- Organisations that provide services to older people e.g. Blue Mountains Food Service.
- Seniors that have demonstrated leadership in the community e.g. taken up leadership positions within community groups.

Previous recipients of a seniors recognition award cannot be nominated.



Administration Process

Nominations must be printed clearly. All sections of the nomination form must be completed.
