



Footpath Renewal: Station Street Wentworth Falls

Council will be renewing the western footpath on Station Street, Wentworth Falls.

In response to pavement damage caused by the existing claret ash trees having insufficient room for further growth (and damage to the trees), Council will be replacing them with ten new lipstick maple trees (pictured, right).

The new trees are better suited to the streetscape and will have sufficient volume for growth, allowing for a long-lasting pedestrian surface.

While parking will be affected on the shop side of the street during the period of the works, measures will be in place to limit disruption to both business and the community.

Proposed Timeline: 27 January 2021 – 1 April 2021
