

KATOOMBA WASTE MANAGEMENT FACILITY - OPERATIONAL IMAGES



- ↑ The Waste Transfer Station at Katoomba WMF commenced operation in June 2010. It is designed to receive mixed waste and recyclables for processing and baling.
- ↓ Mixed waste is tipped onto the platform, recoverable material is manually removed and then waste is pushed onto the conveyor by a front end loader.





- ↑ The 'Harris Badger' baler can process both mixed waste and recyclables.
- ↓ Bales are handled by a 'telehandler'. This machine is ideal for loading trucks and manoeuvring bales.





↑ The purpose built trucks are loaded with bales for transport to Blaxland WMF. The landfill operation at Katoomba WMF ceased in June 2010.

↓ The small vehicle drop off area for waste and recyclables.





- ↑ The Reuse Shed at Katoomba WMF - goods that are in acceptable condition for reuse are available to the public free of charge.
